Last year's budget was \$31,200. Spent \$29,000. Excess \$1,200

Budget Changes

- Adjust revenue on Sock Walk fundraiser
- Educational expenses less due to lack of advisor for Little Lancers
- 5th grade increase of students
- Knoebel's raised cost of 5th grade trip
- Split administrative costs into Office and PTO
- Teacher support \$500 for Mrs. Ellis reading program and Schick lab; historically spending her own money
