## What We're Learning:

- → Reading/Language Arts We have been working on the word family -all, nouns (people, places, animals, and things), plurals (more than one), words ending with -ng, and have continued working on the bonus letter rule.
- Writing We have continued to work on adding catchy introductions and conclusions to our writing. We have begun creating table of contents and chapters for our stories.
- → Math In Unit 4, we have been working on measuring with non-standard units (anything but a ruler) and addition and subtraction. With addition, we have been working on combinations of 10 (adding within 10 fluently) and recognizing and adding double facts (1+1, 2+2, 5+5, 10+10). We have also been working on skip counting by 2's and 3's.
- → Science We have discussed animal groups, such as mammals, amphibians, birds, fish, reptiles, and insects and discussed how each group is different.
- → Social Studies We have been discussing winter holidays celebrated around the world, including Hanukkah, Kwanzaa, Las Posadas, St. Nicholas's Day (Sinterklaas), and Christmas. We pretended to follow the Gingerbread Man around the world and spend time looking at pictures and maps from the places we traveled (Israel, Africa, Mexico, the Netherlands, and the United States).

First grade will be celebrating the winter season with a "Reindeer Day" on Monday, December 21. Please join us for reindeer crafts, games, and activities from 8:30-10:30! You will be traveling with the students to visit each first grade teacher and create a craft or complete an activity with them.
