### What We're Learning:

- → Reading/Language Arts We have worked on special names of places and reviewed capitalizing names. We have also discussed compound words, words with beginning I-blends, reviewed digraph -sh, and have discussed story setting and the beginning, middle, and ends of stories.
- → Writing We have begun writing opinion stories! We are currently working on picking something we think is the best and trying to explain WHY it's the best by listing as many reasons as we can.
- → Math We been practicing place value and understanding that each digit (number) has its own place. We have been focusing on the tens and ones places. We have worked on measuring using non-standard measurements (such as paper clips and blocks). We learned how to compare numbers and number sentences with the greater than symbol >, the less than symbol <, and the equals sign =.</p>
- → Science We have continued discussing weather. We have learned that a meteorologist is someone who studies and reports on the weather. We found out that weather doesn't always stay the same from day to day or season to season but that it constantly changes. We have discussed different types of weather, such as rain, sun, snow, wind, blizzard.
- → Social Studies We discussed Martin Luther King, Jr. and why he is such an important man. We discussed words such as segregation, marches, boycott, and sit-ins and talked about how MLK, Jr helped make laws more fair for all Americans.
