

HOW TO GET STARTED

CrisisGo is a powerful emergency response app that School Districts use to connect with parents, students, and staff through voice, pictures, audio, video, location, files, and SMS text.

1 DOWNLOAD THE CRISISGO APP

Search for the CrisisGo app on the Apple App Store or Google Play Store and download.

2 SET UP YOUR ACCOUNT

Sign up for free or if your school provided you with an account, sign in with that username and password.

3 SUBSCRIBE TO GROUPS

Tap the plus icon in upper right and then tap Subscribe. Enter the group ID in the field and tap search. The group will appear below. Tap the plus icon to join.

To the right of this page is a list of schools and their ID's to subscribe to.

4 STAY SAFE

Follow your schools and groups. Stay up to date on all announcements and emergencies.

Staff Receive Personal Panic Buttons

- Press the Panic Button to set off audible alerts to school safety team members.
- Panic Alert sends a GPS location to speed emergency response.
- Voice, text and video messaging available for each Panic Button incident.
- CrisisGo platform saves all communications for training and after incident reports.



Parents Receive Emergency Notifications

- Distribute District-wide and school site emergency notifications.
- Inform parents of school emergencies and closings.
- Maintain two-way communications with safety teams and parents during emergencies.
- Give your parents community access to the School Safety App at no cost.
