- VII. Environmental Q & A- Due to excellent work by Mr. Bubb and his staff, humidity levels were low and air quality standards were tested and reported as excellent.
- VIII. Workplace Safety Audit-Annual lead testing for water is now mandatory. All water pipes were replaced in 2005. Chemicals in school water are tested quarterly with good results. Dr. Greevy asked if filters in fountains are changed regularly. Mr. Bubb will check on that immediately.
