

Robert W. Grantier Memorial Scholarship

The Robert Grantier Memorial Scholarship Fund was established by The Lancer Foundation in 2016. The criterion for the award includes the following:

- The award will be given to a Loyalsock Township High School senior.
- The students should be in good academic standing.
- The student should possess strong leadership qualities in the school district setting and in the community.
- Additional attributes for consideration include integrity, character and team player.
- Preference will be given to applicants planning to pursue post-secondary training or education but it is not a requirement for eligibility.

Application process:

1. Submit a completed application, list of achievements and essay.
2. All applications will be submitted to the Loyalsock Township High School guidance office.
3. The Loyalsock Township High School scholarship committee will review, screen and make a recommendation to The Lancer Foundation based on the scholarship criteria, school and community involvement and essay.
4. The initial dollar amount recommended is \$500.00
