



College/University Visiting Representative & Coach Protocol Loyalsock Township High School

Rationale: LTHS values exposing students and student-athletes to opportunities at the post-secondary level via meeting with a variety of colleges/universities. LTHS has a long-standing past practice of having Admissions reps access to our students so that students and families can be as informed as possible about potential future decisions. Moreover, LTHS has provided access to reps & coaches from various D I, II, and III institutions who can expose student-athletes to additional opportunities. Because we ultimately value the importance of academic instructional time each day, LTHS has identified specific times in which students can meet with such representatives. The following is the process for establishing a time for the general student population and student athletes (students in grades 11 or 12) to meet with college/university representatives and/or coaches.

General Student Information Sessions with College/University Admissions Reps

1. All college/university admissions representatives should schedule a date and time to meet with interested students through communicating with Mrs. Victoria Campman, 11-12 School Counselor, by calling 570-326-3581, or email: vcampman@loyalsocklancers.org.
2. Days/times of the week: Monday through Friday, either during the school's Lancer Period (2:20 – 3:00 p.m.) or over the school's lunch rotations (12:20-12:50 p.m. or 1:05 -1:35 p.m.)
3. *It is understood that only potential students who are interested in the respective visiting college/university should attend the Admission rep's visitation.*

Student-Athlete Information Sessions with College/University Coaches/Reps

1. All college/university coaches/representatives should schedule a date and time to meet with interested student-athletes through communicating with Mr. Ron Insinger, Athletic Director, by calling 570-326-3581, or email: rinsinge@loyalsocklancers.org.
2. If a college coach/rep has been in contact with the head coach of a LTHS athletic program, **the LTHS head coach shall inform and communicate with Mr. Insinger** to arrange for a date and time for the coach/rep to meet with student athletes.
3. *It is understood that only potential student athletes who are interested in the respective visiting college/university should attend the coach/rep visitation.*
4. Once a date has been established, the specific times in which student athletes can meet with a coach/rep include:
 - a. Prior to the beginning of the school day (7:30 a.m. – 7:50 a.m.)
 - b. During students' lunch rotations (12:20-12:50 p.m. or 1:05-1:35 p.m.)
 - c. During Lancer Period (2:20 – 3:00 p.m.)
 - d. After the school day has concluded (3:00 – 3:30 p.m.)
5. It is understood that, under some specific conditions, a given representative/coach's time, while in the region, may not fall within these times and necessitate an alternate time.
