FREE MEALS AVAILABLE WHILE SCHOOLS ARE CLOSED

Schools closed due to the coronavirus (COVID-19) are able to provide free meals to all students through the National School Lunch Program's Seamless Summer Option. These meals are available for all families and to any child age 18 and younger.

The Loyalsock Township School District invites families and care-givers to drive through* and pick up meals for their children beginning on <u>Tuesday, March 17th and until school resumes</u>. Lunch and breakfast for the following day will be provided on a first come, first served basis. **Children must be present in order for meals to be provided.** Please stay in your car and meals will be passed through based on the number of children in the car.

Cereal, yogurt, muffins and cereal bars are some of the items that will be provided for breakfast. Breakfast bags will also include fruit, juice, and milk.

Lunches may include sandwiches, fresh vegetables, fruit or juice and milk.

We encourage families to continue to be proactive in reducing the risk of coronavirus (COVID-19) by not congregating at the pick-up site once meals have been distributed, continuing to wash your hands often, sneeze or cough into a tissue, and stay home if you are sick.
