Loyalsock Township School District Guidance for Parents and Guardians Regarding Quarantine/Absence from School

The Pandemic continues to provide us with challenges delivering instruction to our students at all levels. Our employees have worked extremely hard to meet the needs of our students. In order to provide direction for students, parents and guardians, we are sharing the following information.

Students who are on quarantine by the Pennsylvania Department of Health or the Loyalsock Township School District are required to sign into classes (Zoom) with their respective teacher or teachers throughout the school day.

Students who have been identified with remote learning for the second semester also are required to sign into classes (Zoom) with their respective teacher or teachers throughout the school day.

Students who are on homebound instruction have the ability to sign into classes (Zoom) with their respective teacher or teachers throughout the school day.

If a student is absent from school for sickness or vacation, they will not have the ability to sign into classes (Zoom) with their respective teacher or teachers.

They will have the option of contacting their teachers to request homework/school work or make this work up upon their return. Homework/classwork will be available electronically from the teacher either through email, Seesaw, Moodle or Google Classroom.
