- III. Occupational Injuries: There was none to report this month.
- IV. Safe Schools Grant Update: Entranceways have been completed. A variance was filed for ½ inch short from entrance door to the pass-through lock boxes. We have installed 77 new cameras at the high school. Currently, Schick is being wired for cameras and they will be installed with the next week.

- VI. 20-21 Athletic and Extra-Curricular Reopening: PIAA making an official statement on Friday, August 21, 2020 for the athletic program to follow the district plan. PMEA Band the projection will probably be that everything will go remote. Non-school related events will not be allowed on school property at this time.
- VII. 20-21 School Year Reopening Planning: DOH clarified the guidelines in July for back to school. They are requiring social distancing of six feet and facemask to be worn at all-time within the school. Masks can be removed during lunch to eat and scheduled mask breaks have been built into the scheduled school day. Mr. Baker designed a plexiglass stand for teachers desk. Mr. Bubb and Mr. Baker put these together. Teachers will be supplied with face shields, cloth mask, gloves, paper towels, and disinfected spray. The re-opening of school will be a staggered start with students A-J starting on Monday, August 31st and K-Z starting on Tuesday, September 1st. All students will be in the building starting Wednesday, September 2nd.
