VI. COVID-19 Updates:

Dan advised the committee that Mr. McLaughlin should be receiving notification on additional clinics for the vaccine and will pass that information onto staff. There is a clinic this weekend in Milton.

Recently, we had some increase in the number of Covid-related incidences and HS/MS went remote learning as of March 23, 24, 25, and 26th. The intension is to return to in-class instruction starting Monday, March 29th. Even with the governors new recommendations, Loyalsock School District plans to stay the status quo for now.

LTSD will be receiving federal funds due to Covid stimulus. Ideas on spending this money are in the following areas.

- Installing an air filter system (currently located only in nurses offices) that fights environmental/air borne bacteria. We are in the process of getting quotes for all buildings.
- The federal stimulus indicates that 20% of the funds received should be applied to educational cost in helping educate our kids and getting them back on track.

- School Police Update: Dan updated the committee on new mandates for police in our buildings. The states are mandating that our SROs have additional training. This will require more cost to the district and time for officers to complete this training.
- Operations Update: Please continue to social distance and wear a mask.
