

Step 1: Contact the school nurse.

Step 2: The nurse will advise you to quarantine for 10 days from start of exposure to COVID-19 contact. Please follow nurse's directions.

**If the student has a COVID-19 test on day 5 after the date of exposure and the results are negative, he/she will only need to quarantine for 7 days.

Step 3: Monitor for fever, cough, shortness of breath, and other symptoms of COVID-19. Contact medical provider if symptoms develop.



Report to School

Students can return to school AFTER the following criteria are met and verified by school nurse:

- They have quarantined for 10 days
- They have remained fever free for 24 hours without fever reducing medication
- Symptoms have improved (if applicable)

recommended that vaccinated individuals monitor for signs and symptoms and get tested 3-5 days after exposure, even if they don't have symptoms.

*CDC CLOSE CONTACT EXCEPTION: In the K-12 indoor classroom setting, the close contact definition excludes students who were within 3 to 6 feet of an infected student (laboratory-confirmed or a clinically compatible illness) if both the infected student and the exposed student(s) correctly and consistently wore well-fitting masks the entire time. This exception does not apply to teachers,

> staff, or other adults in the indoor classroom setting.
