

Curriculum Map: Spanish 4

Course: ADV SPANISH V Sub-topic: Spanish

Grade(s): 11 to 12

Course Description: Spanish 4 is a proficiency-based course that involves meaningful use of language for communicative purposes. Instruction focuses on what students can do with the language. Students will interact and communicate with others while gaining an understanding of and respect for the cultural perspectives, practices and products of different cultures. Critical thinking skills will be strengthened and deepened through problem-solving, conceptualizing and reasoning. Connections are made between cross-curricular content areas.

Students will be able to participate in conversations that go beyond their everyday. They will be able to talk in an organized way and with more detail about events and experiences in various time frames. They are able to describe people, places, and things in an organized way and spontaneously, and in detail. They should be able to handle a familiar situation with an unexpected complication.

Course Goal:

All students will be able to use their Spanish to engage in intermediate high level conversation, to comprehend and interpret spoken and written language, and to present above intermediate level information, values and ideas, while also continuing gaining an understanding of the perspectives and values of the Spanish culture. Through language study, students will make connections with other content areas, compare the language and culture studied with their own.
