

Loyalsock Township Little Lancer Pre-K Program

The Little Lancer Pre-K program allows eligible families with children who are 4 years old by August 31 to apply for our approved high-quality, pre-school program at no cost.

The Loyalsock Township School District Pre-K Counts application for the 2024-2025 school year is available. Families living in Pennsylvania with children who meet the required criteria have priority for this program. One of the top priority categories for this program is income eligibility for families meeting the 300% poverty rate. A family of four can earn up to \$93,600 a year and still qualify; an income eligibility chart is provided on the next page.

To apply for the Little Lancer Pre-K Program, please complete the PA Pre-K application and submit the required documents listed below. Applications are available at the District Service Center, 1605 Four Mile Drive, Williamsport. The deadline to apply is May 10, 2024. Applications received after the deadline will be placed on the prioritized waitlist.

What to bring to enrollment:

Application Checklist

Please submit copies of the items listed below with your application:

- Child's Birth Certificate
- Child's Social Security Card or Number on Tax Return
- Parent/Guardian Photo ID
- Proof of Residency: Lease/Deed or Mortgage Coupon
- Proof of residency
- 2023 Federal Income Tax Return for all adults (18 and over) residing in your household.

ONLY the first 2 pages of Federal Form 1040; no other tax forms are required (if applicable)



The following items are due upon acceptance into the program. You may submit these forms with your application; however, they are not required for the application process.

- Child's Immunization Records
- Child's Physical (completed after September 1, 2023), including vision, hearing, and dental screenings.

Income Eligibility

To be eligible for Pre-K Counts, a family's annual income may not exceed 300% of poverty. **2024 Federal Poverty Guidelines**

Frequently Asked Questions

- If my income is over the 300% FPR, can I still apply? **No**
- If my income is over the 300% FPR, can I pay for my child to attend? **No**
- Is transportation provided? **Yes**
- If my child receives Early Intervention Service, can they attend? **Yes, we will coordinate services with outside agencies.**
- Where is the Little Lancer Pre-K Program held? **Donald E. Schick Elementary School**
- Deadline for application? **Tentatively May 10, 2024**
- When will I know if my child is accepted? **Acceptance into the program will be announced on or before August 19, 2024**
