

LOYALSOCK TOWNSHIP HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT & BEHAVIOR AGREEMENT FORM 2025–2026 School Year

Purpose:

Loyalsock Township High School is committed to providing a safe, respectful, and academically focused learning environment. This Code of Conduct outlines the expectations for student behavior in school, on school property, at school-sponsored events, and while using school transportation. All students are expected to adhere to the values of respect, responsibility, and integrity.

Core Expectations:

1. Respect for Self and Others

- Treat all peers, staff, and visitors with courtesy and kindness.
- Refrain from bullying, harassment, discrimination, or aggressive behavior.
- Use appropriate language and tone in all settings.

2. Academic Integrity

- Complete assignments honestly and independently unless instructed otherwise.
- Do not engage in plagiarism, cheating, or unauthorized collaboration.

3. Attendance and Punctuality

- Attend school regularly and arrive on time.
- Follow proper procedures when absent, tardy, or requesting early dismissal.

4. Dress Code Compliance

- Follow the school's dress code as outlined in the student handbook.
- Avoid attire that is disruptive, inappropriate, or unsafe.

5. Technology and Cell Phone Usage

- Follow the school's cell phone policy, including classroom, hallway, and bathroom expectations.
- Use school technology responsibly and only for academic purposes.

6. Substance-Free Environment

- Possession or use of tobacco, vaping devices, alcohol, or drugs is strictly prohibited.
- Violations will result in disciplinary actions and potential law enforcement involvement.

Consequences for Misconduct:

- Warnings or parent/guardian contact
- Detention, in-school suspension (MRC), or out-of-school suspension
- Loss of privileges or participation in activities
- Referral to the school counselor or administration
- Police involvement, where appropriate
