Loyalsock Township High School (LTHS) is a comprehensive 9-12 public school located in Loyalsock Township, positioned on the east side of Williamsport, Pennsylvania. Servicing a population of 12,000, most of the approximately 500 students comprise middle socioeconomic status. A sizable number/variety of small businesses and retail establishments represent much of the economy within the school district's boundaries.

LTHS provides students with a comprehensive, 21st-century learning environment, including enriching and well-rounded experiences. LTHS utilizes robust 1:1 iPad technology within a hybrid block-schedule (86-minute blocks and 40-minute periods). Students schedule 8 credits per year.
